

Are You Ready for LegitScript?

If you prescribe peptides, GLP-1s, or hormone therapy, LegitScript certification is what unlocks card processing and Google and Meta ads. **Prepared clinics certify in 2 to 4 weeks. Unprepared clinics take 3 to 4 months.** This page tells you which one you are. Check every box you can honestly check today.

1. Your clinical model Every box here must be checked. If one is not, stop and fix it before you apply.

- ☐ A licensed provider (MD, DO, NP, or PA) evaluates every patient and makes the prescribing decision. A questionnaire alone does not count.
- ☐ Your providers are licensed in every state where your patients are located, not just the state your clinic is in.
- ☐ Every product you sell is legal to prescribe and compound today. No research-use-only peptides, nothing labeled "not for human consumption," nothing on FDA's do-not-compound list.
- ☐ Your pharmacy is a licensed 503A or 503B, and you can give its name and license number. "We use accredited pharmacies" is not enough.

2. Your paperwork LegitScript asks for all of it. Gather it before you apply, not after.

- ☐ Formation documents, state business registration, physical address, and ID for each owner
- ☐ License numbers for every prescriber, by state
- ☐ Pharmacy names and license numbers
- ☐ Business Associate Agreements with every vendor that touches patient data: EHR, telehealth platform, email, scheduling, payments
- ☐ HIPAA training records, written privacy and security policies, and a breach-response plan
- ☐ Written refund and cancellation policy, patient complaint process, adverse-event reporting process, and telehealth consent
- ☐ Ten years of disciplinary history for the business, its owners, and its practitioners, disclosed up front. Undisclosed history is a denial, not a delay.

3. Your website and ads LegitScript reviews the live site. Most deficiency notices come from this section.

- ☐ "Prescription required" appears next to every medication and every price
- ☐ Privacy policy written to the HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices standard, not a generic template
- ☐ Terms of service and a working way for patients to reach you
- ☐ Pricing and cancellation terms are visible before checkout
- ☐ No "get semaglutide online," no guaranteed results, no before-and-after photos without context
- ☐ Your ads and social posts say the same thing your website says

4. What to expect

Item	The honest version
Cost through EMS	\$2,000 per year through our processor's enterprise program (about \$3,125 direct). The discount requires processing with us for one year and a personal guaranty. If you leave early, the fee reverts to \$6,000.
Timeline	Complete application: typically 2 to 4 weeks. Every missing item adds a deficiency notice and weeks of back-and-forth. Slow replies to LegitScript are the number one cause of delay.
Who you deal with	You contract with LegitScript directly and own the portal. Forward every LegitScript request to EMS the same day you get it so we can help you answer it.
After certification	You become eligible to apply for Google and Meta healthcare ad verification. Those are separate approvals. Processing opens as soon as your merchant account is boarded.

Score yourself. Section 1 fully checked and most of 2 and 3: you are 2 to 4 weeks away, call us. Section 1 fully checked but gaps in 2 or 3: send us this page with your boxes marked and we will tell you what to fix first. Any box in Section 1 unchecked: certification is not available yet, and neither is compliant processing.
